


# Russian Language Summer School

at Financial University,  
Moscow

July 2024



If you examine the ethnic composition of any country, you will see various nationalities, ethnicities and diasporas, with a different language spoken in each of them. Even in the countries where people of one ethnicity live, they use regional dialects. In order to get to know these peoples and regional ethnic groups better and build a favorable living environment for their development, we need an intermediary language.



Throughout the history of Russia, the Russian language has been an intermediary language that opened the creative world of poets, writers and scholars who were of different nationalities and belonged to various ethnic groups living in Russia. The list includes Rasul Gamzatov, a famous Avar poet, Fazil Iskander, an Abkhaz poet and writer, Vasil Bykov, a Belarusian writer and many others, whose works made a huge contribution to Soviet, Russian and world literature.

We are glad to invite you to join our **Summer School of the Russian Language and Culture** at the Financial University and take your first step on the way to discovering works of Soviet and Russian literature created by the Soviet and Russian people composed of many ethnic groups.

At the Summer School at the Financial University in Moscow, you will have an opportunity to take classes of the Russian language, participate in a multifaceted cultural program and see famous sites, landmarks and significant historical sites.

The student cohort will be divided into **groups of 7 to 10 people**. Student group composition will depend on the level of knowledge of the Russian language. At the end of the program, a Financial University **certificate** will be awarded to the Summer School students.



A **2 to 3 week program** includes:

- Preliminary tests
  - Russian language classes (40 - 60 hours): reading, writing, speaking, listening comprehension, phonetics and grammar rules
  - Final tests and individual counselling based on their results
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- Recommendations for the independent study of the Russian language
  - A short English-language lecture course in the Culture and History of Russia (10 hours)
  - A cultural program and tours



A program **for beginners** will give you an opportunity to:

- Learn the Russian alphabet and acquire basic writing skills
- Learn the basics of the Russian grammar
- Learn the most common words and phrases
- Learn the vocabulary that is used in everyday life situations, incl. in shops, cafes, in the street, when traveling, etc.
- Acquire listening comprehension skills to be able to understand the announcements pronounced in stores, at the railway stations, and in the subway

Our program for **intermediate level** students will help them to:

- Review and systematize the knowledge of the basic Russian grammar
- Overcome the language barrier
- Learn to read and analyze articles, short stories and news texts
- Learn to communicate in Russian on the Internet (at the forum pages, in blogs, in the social media)
- Learn to prepare short presentations in Russian



Our program for the **advanced level** students includes a course of the Russian language for business and finance. There should be a group of at least 8 student participants to start a course.
